Guest Speaker – December 16 RANDY WILSON "Brief History of Sound for TV and Film"

In September 2025 he was awarded two additional Emmys for his work on The Studio and The Last of Us.



Despite the snowfall, we had an excellent turnout. The buffet was delicious and the luncheon was enjoyed by all.








